



HOW TO:

step by step application and removal, using the **Portable Light**

APPLICATION:

Step One: Preparation



- Brush **Prep MAX ADHESION SANITIZER** on to clean nails. This essential first step will remove any residue from the nails, to aid effective application of your care, colour and finish products for a long-lasting result.

Step Two: Care and Colour

For ease of application and curing, we recommend performing the following steps first on your four finger nails. Once your four finger nails have been cured under the light, you can repeat each step for your thumb nail.



- Apply a thin coat of **Structure BASE COAT GEL**.
- Cure under the **Portable Light** for one minute.



- Apply a thin coat of your choice of colour from the **LED GEL POLISH** range.
- Cure under the **Portable Light** for three minutes for darker colours, or two minutes for lighter colours.
- Apply your second coat of colour and cure again under the **Portable Light** for another three minutes for darker colours, or two minutes for lighter colours.



- Apply a thin coat of **Brilliance SEAL & SHINE TOP COAT GEL**.
- Cure under the **Portable Light** for two minutes.

Step Three: Finish



- Remove the tacky residue with **Purify PRE & POST APPLICATION CLEANSER**.

REMOVAL:

Step One: Preparation



- Buff the surface of the nail to break the top coat seal.

Step Two: Removal

For ease of removal, prepare ten squares of foil, each about 5cm square, before you begin this stage.



- Saturate a cotton ball with **Erase GEL NAIL POLISH REMOVER**.
- Place the cotton ball onto the nail and wrap in aluminium foil.



- Leave the nail wrapped in foil for 10-15 minutes.



- Unwrap the nail and slide the cotton ball off.
- Using an orange stick, gently scrape off any remaining colour.

Step Three: Finish



- Massage **Revitalize NOURISHING CUTICLE OIL** into the cuticle and natural nail.
